

North Cascades Regional Addendum

Open Positions: One Field Project Specialist – North Cascades (Southern Washington - Northern Washington)

18-week seasonal position starting the week of June 8 and ending in early October. This position will be participating in a variety of trail maintenance projects across the region, including logout (primarily with crosscut saws), drainage, tread and other deferred maintenance. There will also be the opportunity to complete dry stone masonry projects for candidates with that skillset. Work will be a combination of leading volunteer trail crews and overseeing and supporting Washington Conservation Corps (WCC) crews. WCC Crews operate on an 8 days on and 6 days off schedule in July and August. June and September will primarily involve leading and supporting volunteer projects. This work will include projects throughout the region, with locations subject to change depending on weather and other conditions. Possible work locations include:

- Mt. Baker-Snoqualmie National Forest
- Okanogan-Wenatchee National Forest
- Gifford Pinchot National Forest
- Mt. Rainier National Park



North Cascades Regional Office and Duty Station:

Field Project Specialists work under the direct supervision of the North Cascades Regional Representative. When not in the field, the Field Project Specialists will work from an agreed upon remote duty station or from the regional office in North Bend, WA.
